

Instructions for ePoster Presenters

Update issued September 12th, 2022

Submitting ePosters

The Conference is **now ready to accept ePosters** from those authors invited to submit them. The **OAT2022 Presenter Guidelines** can be found on the FAQ page on the OAT2022 website (<https://www.internationaloat.com/program/faq/presenters>). Please refer to these when preparing your ePoster.

When naming your ePoster file, use family name, then given name, Abstract Number then version date. For example: **Fernandez_Belinda_poster_#32_16Sep22.pptx**.

ePosters must be emailed to admin@giwa.org.au by **Sunday October 2nd**.

Because all ePosters must be pre-loaded into the Conference app, **posters received after Sunday October 2nd will not be accepted**.

If your ePoster file is too large to email, please send using Dropbox or WeTransfer or similar file transfer tool.

ePoster authors are invited to deliver their poster as a stand-alone PowerPoint presentation split across no more than two pages/slides.

Participants in the Conference will be able to access both the ePoster and the supporting abstract via the Conference app, so choose a level of detail that you think best represents your work and will reach the widest audience. Include a head-and-shoulders photo of yourself on the first page so that Conference participants can recognise and seek you out during the Conference.

Viewing ePosters

Posters will be screened on the large screens in the same rooms where the oral and virtual presentations will be given during the Conference, during morning and afternoon tea and lunch breaks. Posters will be aligned with and screened during the breaks of those themed sessions in the Program that best fit the poster topic. Eg. Genomics and bioinformatics related posters will be screened during breaks in the Genomics and Bioinformatics themed oral and virtual presentations.

It is anticipated Posters will be screened 2-3 times over the course of the Conference, with these **times being shown in the Program eBook**.

Where possible, **poster authors are asked to be present in the room when their poster is being screened** to enable Conference participants to engage with authors.

Posters will also be available to participants via the Conference app, during the Conference and for a further 30 days after the Conference concludes.
